



## WHITE WINE

### 1 - CHARDONNAY

#### FREEDOM CROSS - SOUTH AFRICA

Tropical fruit and melon aromas on the nose are complimented by hints of vanilla and butterscotch. The palate is full flavored and creamy with a rich satisfying finish. A wine for those that enjoy a richer style of Chardonnay

### 2 - COQUILLE DE MER

#### VERMINTINO - FRANCE

A wonderfully exotic and lighter style of dry white, using grapes grown within sight of the azure Mediterranean. A delicious, zingy/zesty dry.

### 3 - SAUVIGNON BLANC

#### El Picador - CHILE

This refreshing Sauvignon Blanc has flavours of Citrus, Melon and herbs as well as a crisp, clean finish. Produced by Chile's No1 Wine Producer, it boasts a fruity gooseberry palate leading to a quenching dry after-taste.

### 4 - PINOT GRIGIO

#### CA' TESORE - ITALY

A real Pinot Grigio - dry and rounded, subtle floral notes with hints of almond butter, lime and peach. This is a crackling dry and Zesty white with a real elegance and nice depth of character

### 5 - MINERALIUM

#### CHININ BLANC - FRANCE

This bone dry white shows terrific balance, with refreshing acidity and minerality. The Limestone mouth-feel is supplemented by juicy grapefruit aromas on the finish

### 6 - GRENACHE DE VISU 172

#### XAVIER ROGER - FRANCE

A charming white Grenache whose name derives from the grape growth cycle, exactly 172 days between spring bud break and autumn leaf fall. Rich and expressive with notes of white peach, mango and a touch of lime blossom

### 7 - MULLER-THURGAU

#### CANTINA LAVIS - ITALY

Full, fruity aromas of green apple and lychee, coupled with floral hints of lily and jasmine. Rich and balanced on the palate, mellow and well structured

### 8 - SAUVIGNON BLANC

#### CLOUDY BAY - NEW ZEALAND

Bright, focused citrus aromatics of grapefruit and kaffir lime are supported by subtle tropical notes. A silky, concentrated palate reveals ripe, juicy stone fruit and lemon grass with racy acidity leading to a mouthwatering, persistent finish.

## ROSE WINE

### 9 - COQUILLE de FLEUR

#### IGP PAYS d'OC - FRANCE

A light and fresh rose, with fruit flavoured aromas and notes of wild raspberry and candied strawberry

### 10 - ZINFANDEL ROSE

#### ANGELS FLIGHT - USA

Bright aromas of strawberry and watermelon lead to a full, ripe and juicy strawberry fruit flavours and a hint of cream, balanced with a refreshing mouth-feel and a slightly crisp, lingering finish.

## RED WINE

### 11 - FETEASCA NEAGRA

#### PAPARUDA, CRAMELE RECAS - ROMANIA

Legend has it that the Banat region of Romania was where Bacchus the god of wine spent his childhood. Feteasca Neagra red is a rich and ripe, loaded with dark berry and cherry fruit.

### 12 - MALBEC HORNHEAD

#### LANGUEDOC - FRANCE

Soft, fruit-driven yet spicy red, laden with red fruits, coffee, spice and elegant tannins.

### 13 - RIOJA TEMPRANILLO

#### BODEGA MUERZA - SPAIN

Cracking soft sensual red, with flavours of black fruits, spice and chocolate made by one of the oldest estates in the region.

### 14 - GRENACHE MERLOT

#### RICHELIEU - FRANCE

With aromas of plum jam, raspberry, spice and a touch of pepper. The palate is soft and smooth with ripe red fruits and a touch of pepper on the finish.

### 15 - BULLS BLOOD

#### TALISMAN - HUNGARY

Bulls Blood is one of Hungary's most famous wines dating back to 1552. Intense aromas of dark fruits and ripe plums balanced with notes of black pepper and hints of autumnal leaves

### 16 - GAUDEAMUS ROBLE

#### BODEGA HERMANOS DEL VILLAR - SPAIN

A rich robust, full bodied dry red, showcasing the jammy black fruits and spice of tempranillo. Complex with notes of liquorice, kirsch and black fruit jam from the warm well sited vineyards

### 17 - CHATEAU FLEUR FOMPEYRE

#### CASTILLON - BORDEAUX

An award-winning easy drinking red from Bordeaux with aromas of black fruits accompanied by woody notes. Silky tannins for a balance on roundness and suppleness with flavours of cassis, black cherries and flora

### 18 - SCOTCHMANS HILL SHIRAZ

#### GEELONG - AUSTRALIA

A complex nose of dark fruit plum and ripe cherry aromas leads seamlessly to spice and pepper notes on the palate with cedar oak to round of the bouquet

### 19 - OLD VINE SHIRAZ

#### BAROSSA - AUSTRALIA

Bright ruby red, with a nose full of expressive cherries, blackberries, liquorice and coffee. A rich medium to full bodied palate with hints of chocolate and dark cherries with soft tannins
