1. Gardet Brut Tradition NV Chigny-les-Roses, Champagne

15

Altogether fresh on the nose, the palate fills and richens with every sip, a sign of the extra mature wines added. A full-bodied consistency, fine acidity and a balance between creamy roasted nut and brioche flavours and bold, steely acidity.

4. Bolney Bubbly, West Sussex – England

13

Delightful floral and brioche notes combine with zesty citrus fruit, honeysuckle and elderflower. It is delicate and well balanced, finishing with a soft fresh hint of sweetness

5. Prosecco D.O.C., Pure - Veneto, Italy

11

The nose gives aromas of pear, white flowers and lemon zest. The palate is clean and crisp with apple notes, leading to a light and refreshing finish.

6. Rosé, Coquille de Fleur - IGP Pays d'Oc, France

8.25

This rosé is a light and fresh wine, with fruit-forward aromas. It displays notes of wild raspberry and candied strawberry. The palate is lively and well-balanced, with mineral elements echoing on the finish.

11. Zinfandel Rose, Angels Flight - California, USA

8.50

Bright aromas of strawberry and watermelon. The full, ripe fruit flavours are well balanced with a refreshing mouthfeel and a slight crisp, lingering finish.

22. Picpoul de Pinet, Terre d'Eole - Languedoc, France

9.95

Brilliant yellow robe with green tints. Flower nose with notes of hawthorn, acacia, but also citrus fruit. Round and mineral wine in the mouth with a grapefruit finish.

24. Sauvignon Blanc, Le Charme by Christine Cabri - IGP Pays du Gers, France

8.50

A fabulous aromatic wine, fresh on the nose with flavours of citrus fruit combined with blackcurrant leaf aromas and a great roundness.

25. Vermentino, Coquille de Mer - Languedoc, France

8.50

Pale lemon in appearance with citrus, apricot and gentle floral aromas. Ripe peach, and tropical notes on the palate. A fruity easy drinking style with good, balanced acidity. Crisp and refreshing.

28. Pinot Grigio, Ca' Tesore - Venetie, Italy

8.50

The nose has hints of lemon balm, green apple and pear and the palate is dry and zesty with vibrant floral notes.

33. Chardonnay, Freedom Cross - Franschhoek, South Africa

8.50

Tropical fruit and melon aromas on the nose are complimented by hints of vanilla and butterscotch. The palate is full flavoured and creamy, with a rich satisfying finish. A wine for those that enjoy a richer style of Chardonnay.

60. Malbec, Hornhead - Languedoc, France

9.25

Deep dark red. Beautiful flavours of dark fruits, amplified with hints of coffee, cocoa and subtle rosemary. Wonderfully harmonic with a round and juicy mouthfeel.

61. Merlot, Le Charme by Philippe Lebrun - IGP Pays d'Oc, France

9.25

A ruby red appearance, with lovely cassis and raspberry flavours and slightly spicy hints. A lot of fruit flavours on the palate with a hint of black pepper at the finish.

64. Rioja Tempranillo, Bodegas Muerza - Rioja, Spain

9.25

An elegant red wine with hints of liquorice and dark fruit both on the nose and the palate. Well-structured and easy to drink due to a low level of tannins.

73. Chianti, Duca di Saragnano, Barbera - Tuscany, Italy 9.95
A fresh clean modern style of Chianti that is easy to drink with food or on its own. Medium bodied with soft red fruits with hints of spice and tobacco on the finish complimented by a smoky note.

77. Pinot Noir, Lautarul, Cremele Recas - Banat, Romania 9.25
Dark in colour, red plum, cherry and mulled spicy aromatics. Beautiful flavours, almost jammy in its concentration. Layers of complex black cherry, raspberry and cinnamon, with a long and lingering finish.

CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING

1. Gardet Brut Tradition NV - Chigny-les-Roses, Champagne 75
Altogether fresh on the nose, the palate fills and richens with every sip, a sign of the extra mature wines added - the palate grows in the glass and seems more expressive and elegant, with a full-bodied consistency, fine acidity and a balance between creamy roasted nut and brioche flavours and bold, steely acidity.

4. Bolney Bubbly, West Sussex - England 75
Delightful floral and brioche notes combine with zesty citrus fruit, honeysuckle and elderflower. It is delicate and well balanced, finishing with a soft fresh hint of sweetness.

5. Prosecco D.O.C., Pure - Veneto, Italy 32
The nose gives aromas of pear, white flowers and lemon zest. The palate is clean and crisp with apple notes, leading to a light and refreshing finish.

7. Bolney Rosé - West Sussex, England 105
Traditional method quality sparkling wine with a fine mousse, tightly beaded. On the nose a touch of yeast with notes of raspberry and wild strawberry

8. Malbec Rose, Gouguenheim - Mendoza, Argentina 45
Delicate with red fruits aromas, predominantly of cherries and strawberries. Very fresh in the mouth, soft tones with equilibrated acidity. Small and brilliant bubbles.

ROSE WINE

9. Rosé, Coquille de Fleur - IGP Pays d'Oc, France 29
This rosé is a light and fresh wine, with fruit-forward aromas. It displays notes of wild raspberry and candied strawberry. The palate is lively and well-balanced, with mineral elements echoing on the finish.

11. Zinfandel Rose, Angels Flight - California, USA 32
Bright aromas of strawberry and watermelon. The full, ripe fruit flavours are well balanced with a refreshing mouthfeel and a slight crisp, lingering finish.

WHITE WINE

FRANCE & EUROPE

12. Pouilly Fumé, Domaine Jean Pabiot - Loire, France 54
Brilliant light yellow. Expressive nose of grapefruit, apple, pear and floral undertones. Lively attack flowing into a suave, full and fresh palate with crisp aromas. Well-balanced, focused and elegant.

13. Gewurztraminer Grand Cru Sporen, Dopff & Irion - Alsace, France 75
Bright gold in appearance. Complex aromas of yellow peach, melon, Mirabelle plum, floral narcissus, peony, almond paste, cinnamon, white pepper. A well balanced palate between the dominant fruity flavours and floral notes. A persistent and fresh finish with highly intense peppery notes.

14. Chablis, Domaine des Marronniers - Burgundy, France 60
Produced from 10 different parcels from vines of between 25-30 years old, this is a delicious and concentrated stony fruit wine, perfectly offset by a beautiful minerality and oyster shell freshness.

15. Mâcon Chardonnay, Domaine Mallory & Benjamin Talmard - Burgundy, France 45
Rich, citrusy fruit, apple and pear with a creamy texture and a delightfully subtle minerality. The extra lees contact seem to add a delicious creaminess.

- 16. Meursault, Domaine Bernard Michelot - Burgundy, France** 145
A basket of sweet buttery fruit, streaks of honey, lime marmalade and a high degree of tropical richness characterize this wine.
- 17. Château d'Argadens, Sauvignon Blanc - Semillon - Bordeaux, France** 43
A delicious bouquet of ripe, tropical fruit with notes of melon, pineapple, gooseberry and Golden Delicious apple. The palate is wonderfully concentrated with a clean citrus streak that keeps the wine energetic and vibrant, all supported by a delicious note of oak that adds weight and structure.
- 18. Chateauneuf du Pape, Domaine du Vieux Télégraphe, Domaine Brunier - Rhone, France** 160
Beautiful characteristics of honey, grapefruit and apricot with a lovely nutty finish.
- 19. Oak Aged Chardonnay 'Les Argelières', Marilyn Lasserre - Languedoc, France** 37
Shimmering gold in the glass, aromas of ripe apples and dainty hints of vanilla and nuts with a buttery note. Dense and velvety on the palate but ever so fresh with a long finish.
- 20. Chenin Blanc, Mineralium - Languedoc, France** 36
Bright and pale yellow in the glass. The nose displays hints of green apple skin, citrus fruit and fresh cut grass. This bone-dry white shows terrific balance, with refreshing acidity and minerality. The limestone mouthfeel is supplemented by juicy grapefruit aromas on the finish.
- 21. Marsanne/Viognier, Xavier Roger - Languedoc, France** 40
Shimmery gold in colour. Delicious aromas of ripe apricots and buttery notes. The mouthfeel pleases the palate with a full body and a long finish.
- 22. Picpoul de Pinet, Terre d'Eole - Languedoc, France** 40
Brilliant yellow robe with green tints. Flower nose with notes of hawthorn, acacia, but also citrus fruit. Round and mineral wine in the mouth with a grapefruit finish.
- 23. Grenache, De Visu 172, Xavier Roger - Languedoc, France** 43
Rich and expressive with notes of white peach, mango and a touch of lime blossom.
- 24. Sauvignon Blanc, Le Charme by Christine Cabri - IGP Pays du Gers, France** 33
A fabulous aromatic wine, fresh on the nose with flavours of citrus fruit combined with blackcurrant leaf aromas and a great roundness.
- 25. Vermentino, Coquille de Mer - Languedoc, France** 33
Pale lemon in appearance with citrus, apricot and gentle floral aromas. Ripe peach, and tropical notes on the palate. A fruity easy drinking style with good, balanced acidity. Crisp and refreshing.
- 26. Müller-Thurgau, Cantina Lavis - Trentino, Italy** 40
Bright yellow in appearance, with fruity aromas of green apple and lychee, coupled with floral hints of lily and jasmine. Rich and balanced on the palate, mellow and well structured.
- 27. Tempranillo Blanco, Rioja Vega - Rioja, Spain** 45
On the nose, complex, expressive, with intense notes of tropical fruits and white flowers over delicate aromas of herbs. Unctuous and sweet attack on the mouth which develops into fresh citrus flavours. A subtle silky texture from the ageing on its fine lees in French oak barrels. A complex wine which will keep well for many years to come.
- 28. Pinot Grigio, Ca' Tesore - Venetie, Italy** 33
The nose has hints of lemon balm, green apple and pear and the palate is dry and zesty with vibrant floral notes.
- 29. Gavi 'I Risi', Mario Giribaldi - Piemonte, Italy** 50
Pale straw in colour with the right degree of green fleck and limpid appearance. A full fresh nose with stone fruit notes and a degree of citrus, the palate offers layers of crisp dessert apple, pear and almond nut. Full and round in the mouth with a discrete structure and clean yet 'fresh as a daisy' finish. A light acidic note, typical of this wine makes it a pleasure to drink with all varieties of food.
- 30. Fiano, Carlomagno - Puglia, Italy** 35
Straw yellow shot with green; very full and intensely fruity on the nose with exotic fruit such as melon and banana, featuring hints of citrus reminiscent of grapefruit. On the palate it is very well balanced, with a good acidity backbone and length.
- 31. Gruner Veltliner, Talisman - Tokay, Hungary** 32
Dry in style, this Grüner Veltliner has bright aromas of citrus fruit and green herbs balanced with white pepper and warm spice.

NEW WORLD

- 32. Sauvignon Blanc, Groote Post - Darling Hills, South Africa** 42
On the nose aromas of white stone fruit with balanced minerality and a touch of asparagus. The palate has great length, showing green fig and gooseberry flavours.
- 33. Chardonnay, Freedom Cross - Franschhoek, South Africa** 30
Tropical fruit and melon aromas on the nose are complimented by hints of vanilla and butterscotch. The palate is full flavoured and creamy, with a rich satisfying finish. A wine for those that enjoy a richer style of Chardonnay.
- 34. Jonty's Duck, Avondale - Paarl, South Africa** 50
The nose displays pure fruit; lime, grapefruit and pineapple with just a dash of honey. The palate is dense with ripe flavours and juicy with tangy peach and apricot flavours, delivered with good intensity and freshness.
- 35. Chenin Blanc 'Anima', Avondale - Paarl, South Africa** 60
Anima has a nose that develops intriguingly in the glass. Winter melon, pineapple, lime and a hint of honey confirm the elegance and fullness of this softly wooded, supple Chenin Blanc. The palate is dense with fresh fruit flavours of gooseberry, quince and peach, all harmonising superbly with the soulful minerality that gives this wine its name.
- 37. St Andrews Riesling, Wakefield Estate - Clare Valley, Australia** 85
The wine is a very pale straw colour with a slight green tinge. The nose shows zesty lemon and lime aromas along with faint orange blossom. This Riesling has fresh lemon/lime juice characters and a slate-like minerality across the mid-palate. It is backed up by a persistent and refreshing lime finish.
- 39. Sauvignon Blanc, Cloudy Bay - Marlborough, New Zealand** 96
Bright, focused citrus aromatics of grapefruit and kaffir lime abound, supported by subtle tropical notes. A silky, concentrated palate reveals ripe, juicy stone fruit and lemongrass. Its racy acidity leads toward a mouthwatering, persistent finish, suggesting a sauvignon blanc with ageability.
- 40. Pinot Gris, Domain Road - Central Otago, New Zealand** 50
Pears and stonefruit dominate the bouquet, together with hints of quince. The sweet taste of pears and peaches comes through on the palate. This medium bodied wine has a good texture and fine balance.

RED WINE

FRANCE

- 41. Bourgogne Pinot Noir 'Le Chapitre', Domaine Machard de Gramont - Burgundy, France** 55
Whilst the 2019 vintage was early for reds, in 2020 they picked a week later, and the colours show more concentration. The wine is firm, quite upright and to the fore. Red fruits very much to the front, with streaks of crème de Mure and ripe, rounded tannins and notes of minerals and spice. The finish is long, rounded, firm and sweetened by the stewed red fruits.
- 42. Nuits-Saint-Georges Vieilles Vignes, Machard de Gramont** 110
There is black fruit aplenty, concentrated, and intense, with a muscular and powerful frame of fruit, tannins and spice. This is a dense and structured Pinot, showing all the power of Nuits, but with a sweetened core of fruit that wells up from the glass to mask the weight of the wine. Long, powerful, very good.
- 43. Fleurie, Domaine Pardon - Beaujolais, France** 52
The nose displays ripe strawberry character with notes of fresh hedgerow fruits. The palate is light and soft with wonderful texture and elegance. Smooth and supple this is a great example of modern, fruit forward Beaujolais.
- 44. Moulin-à-Vent 'La Rochelle', Olivier Merlin - Beaujolais, France** 85
A deeply and intensely coloured wine. Attractive aromatic expression of spices (pepper) and well-ripened cherry. In the mouth, highly concentrated with well-marked but velvety tannins. Attractive aromatic expression of spices and well-ripened cherry.
- 45. Château Fleur Fompeyre, Castillon - Bordeaux, France** 38
Deep purple colour. The nose develops notes of black fruits accompanied by woody and melted notes. The mouth gives way to silky tannins for a balance on roundness and suppleness. The palate is faithful to the nose with aromas of cassis, black cherries and flora.

- 47. Château Bonalque, Pomerol - Bordeaux, France** 180
This wine is deep purple in colour, powerful and opulent on the bouquet that screams ripe plum characters. The palate is very rich with multiple layers of chocolate and liquorice.
- 48. Château Grand Mayne - Grand Cru St Émilion, Bordeaux, France** 200
The bouquet is overt with concentrated plum fruits, a touch of smoke and spice with freshness abound. The palate is finely crafted with a dense core of black fruits, and grippy tannins providing sturdy support.
- 49. Château Léoville Barton 2ème Cru, St Julien - Bordeaux, France** 240
The bouquet is classic Medoc, smouldering with hints of cedar and cigar box, whilst the palate is powerful and packed with delicious cassis fruit.
- 52. Château Clément-Pichon, Haut-Médoc - Bordeaux, France** 95
A very impressive, overt bouquet with dark fruits and a touch of stewed plum. The palate is soft and linear with a well defined structure. Rich in creamy black fruits with an emphasis on cassis and cedar, the tannins are firm and there is a refreshing balance. The finish is long and lingering, round and stylish. What great value this is!
- 53. Le Pigeolet des Brunier 2020, Domaine Brunier - Ventoux, France** 48
This wine is a blend of 80% Grenache Noir, 10% Syrah, 5% Carignan, 5% Cinsault, produced from two separate vineyards. The first is a 7ha parcel in the municipality of Caromb in the Côtes de Ventoux, while the second is a 3ha vineyard situated right on the boundary of Châteauneuf-du-Pape. The average age of the vines is 25 years old. Rammed with ripe fruits with an interlacing of wild herbs, this is an immensely gluggable glass of red and delivers stupendous value for money.
- 54. Gigondas 'Terrace du Diable', Domaine Les Pallières - Rhone, France** 110
A Complex, intense wine that oozes class. This cuvee possesses a greater element of spice and minerality.
- 55. Côtes du Rhône Villages, Les Arbouzes, Massif Uchaux - Rhone, France** 39
Produced by winemaker Marc Thomas who is meticulous in using the different appropriate vinification methods available for each different parcel of Grenache, Syrah and Carignan vines. A lovely fruit packed wine.
- 56. Chateauneuf du Pape, Domaine Les Galets de Berthaude - Rhone, France** 75
Dark in colour, ranging from ruby-red to almost black. On the nose summer fruit, blackcurrant and blackberry Provençal spices (garrigue), pepper, a hint of vanilla with a touch of gaminess. Reliably complex nose. All these aromas resurface on the palate in the company of some very subtle tannins. Generous and mouth-filling, boasting superb persistence on the palate. Lovely fresh finish. Amazingly well-balanced.
- 58. Madiran Plénitude, Plaimont - France** 80
Deep purple in appearance. A rich and complex nose where the aromas of blackcurrant and blackberry combine harmoniously with the aromas of dry fig, and soft spices. Flavours of clove, tobacco and leather combine with prune and black cherry. An elegant and complex wine with a long warm finish.
- 60. Malbec, Hornhead - Languedoc, France** 35
Deep dark red. Beautiful flavours of dark fruits, amplified with hints of coffee, cocoa and subtle rosemary. Wonderfully harmonic with a round and juicy mouthfeel.
- 61. Merlot, Le Charme by Philippe Lebrun - IGP Pays d'Oc, France** 35
A ruby red appearance, with lovely cassis and raspberry flavours and slightly spicy hints. A lot of fruit flavours on the palate with a hint of black pepper at the finish.
- 62. Marie Antoinette, Aubert & Mathieu- Languedoc, France** 50
Produced from very low yields of only 25hl/ha. A savoury bouquet showing roasted, toasted flavours of walnuts and rye, sourdough and tamari. The palate offers a salty tang of umeboshi plums with craggy tannins, and yet they have a sheen to them. Firm, emphatic and fruit packed finish, an atypical Corbières.
- 63. Grenache, De Visu 223, Xavier Roger - Languedoc, France** 38
Overt and spicy aromas with a hint of white pepper, the palate is concentrated with ripe black cherry fruits and liquorice intensity. The varietal character shines through with an underlay of garrigue and a spicy herb finish.

REST OF EUROPE

- 64. Rioja Tempranillo, Bodegas Muerza - Rioja, Spain** 35
An elegant red wine with hints of liquorice and dark fruit both on the nose and the palate. Well-structured and easy to drink due to a low level of tannins.
- 65. Gaudeamus Roble, Bodega Hermanos del Villar - Ribera del Duero, Spain** 42
Lively deep cherry colour, intense red and black fruits aromas combined with a soft touch of wood and caramel. Black ink and minerals. Voluminous with persistence, BIG wine without being overly brooding. Fresh and well-integrated acidity, refined, well balanced and elegant.
- 66. Antona Garcia, Rejadorada - Toro, Spain** 55
Full bodied, intense nose and offering warm and mulled red fruits, nice lick of jam, oak and spice. The tannins wrap around the brooding core, and 30 mins breathing release a richness of fruit and heady, generous structure that really hits the spot.
- 68. Coroa d'Ouro, Manoel Poças - Douro Valley, Portugal** 37
Ruby with a dark core. Clean and fruity notes, with layers of mulled black berry, cherry stone and a wonderfully crunchy, classy baked cherry pie, balanced on a nerve edge of freshness and refined brooding power.... Full-bodied, aromatic and elegant.
- 69. Valpolicella Classico, Giuseppe Lonardi - Veneto, Italy** 43
This has lovely gentle aromas of fresh coffee, kirsch and the palate is very soft and delicate. Rich and fruit driven on the finish this is classic Italian elegance.
- 70. Corvina IGT, Zeni - Veneto, Italy** 39
Bright ruby red in appearance with aromas of fruit and spice. Intense and persistent palate.
- 72. Barolo, Giribaldi - Piemonte, Italy** 85
A ruby red colour with amaranth reflexes, an evident perception of good red fruit appeals to the nose, dried berry and chocolate fruit with Nebbiolo's signature perfume of rose petals and coffee. Full body with soft silky tannins and a juicy finish.
- 73. Chianti, Duca di Saragnano, Barbanera - Tuscany, Italy** 35
A fresh clean modern style of Chianti that is easy to drink with food or on its own. Medium bodied with soft red fruits with hints of spice on the finish complimented by a smoky note.
- 75. Brunello di Montalcino, Col di Lamo - Tuscany, Italy** 152
A perfumed bouquet, there is great brooding intensity and smouldering power. The palate is sumptuous, round and creamy with a sophisticated prune and blackberry fruit structure, delicate nuanced oak ageing and perfectly poised tannins. Quite outstanding.
- 76. Aglianico-Fremondo, La Guardiense - Campania, Italy** 36
Deep red in appearance with garnet hints. Full of cherry and sweet vanilla notes from ageing in wood. This is a powerful and intense wine, with a soft tannic structure and a good finish.
- 77. Pinot Noir, Lautarul, Cremele Recas - Banat, Romania** 34
Dark in colour, red plum, cherry and mulled spicy aromatics. Beautiful flavours, almost jammy in its concentration. Layers of complex black cherry, raspberry and cinnamon, with a long and lingering finish.

NEW WORLD

- 79. Jonty's Duck, Avondale - Paarl, South Africa** 45
On the nose there is lots of blackcurrant and liquorice, with a hint of dark chocolate and ground coffee. The wine has an explosion of creamy red fruits on the palate and well integrated, elegant tannins to support it.
- 80. Old Vine Shiraz, Irvine Estate - Barossa, Australia** 140
Bright ruby red, with a nose full of expressive cherries, blackberries, liquorice and coffee. A rich medium to full bodied palate with hints of chocolate and dark cherries. Soft tannins with persistent flavour and great length.
- 81. Cabernet Sauvignon, Kingston Estate - Clare Valley, Australia** 46
Beautiful complex and smooth oak finish.
- 85. Merlot 'Gran Reserva', Santa Luz - Colchagua Valley, Chile** 35
Aromas of fresh cherry, red currant and plum are wrapped up in a subtle spiciness obtained from 12 months in French and American oak.

86. Cabernet Franc Gran Reserva, Alto Los Romeros - Maule Valley, Chile 35
 Intense and bright ruby red in colour. The wine reveals aromas of plum and dark cherry, combined with spiced and toasted notes from oak barrel ageing. On the palate, the wine is weighty with firm tannins and the finish reveals dark fruit, coffee and light vanilla flavours. This is a wine with great character and body.

88. Malbec, Mendel - Mendoza, Argentina 65
 Displaying the typical aromas of mature fruit, plums, raisins and violets, with full-bodied, meaty flavors.

89. Château Haut-Mayne, Sauternes (50cl) - Bordeaux, France 11 35
 A rich and full wine with aromas of dried fruits. Silky and elegant with good length.

90. Aszú 5 Puttonyos, Grand Tokaj (50cl) - Tokaj, Hungary 17 110
 A wine with very complex, exquisite aromas. Made using botritized shrivelled aszú berries. Flavours and aromas of peach, orange peel, brittle, figs, exotic flowers with a touch of dill at the end. Sampling the wine it has a very clear fruity flavour with orange, quince, pear and apricot notes along with an appearance of white chocolate and vanilla essence. The acids keep the wine round and lengthy. The finish reveals a lime-grapefruit aroma that lingers long in the mouth with a mature coffee aftertaste due to the barrel-ageing process.

91. Elysium Black Muscat, Andrew Quady (37.5cl) - California, USA 12 35
 Elysium is a brilliant crimson purple colour with aromas of ripe berries, rose petals, strawberries and lychees. The vibrant acidity balances beautifully with the sweetness of this wine making it a very refreshing drop.

PORT **50ml**

92. Poças Special Reserve Ruby - Portugal 8
 Lots of raisin, fig and prune hints with a powerful sweetness at its core. In the mouth it has lots of dark fruits and some toffee hints. A great port for all year round.

93. Poças 10 Year Old Tawny Port - Portugal 12
 Tawny and woody bouquet of dried fruits and raisins. Full-bodied, irresistible and complex, with a long lasting finish of dried plums.

94. Fonseca 2003 - Portugal 26
 2003 was a hot year so expect rich, concentrated flavours with great depth and a touch of baked earth. Very intense - delicious!

95. Poças 1997 - Portugal 20
 The nose gives us lots of dark berry fruits, vanilla, cedar and some hints of dried fruits. On the palate there is a herbaceous note and layers of cocoa, spice and rich sweet fruits.

SHERRY **50ml**

96. Gutierrez Colosia Pedro Ximenez 10
 The nose is heady, redolent of raisins, plums and figs. Full, rich, unctuous molasses - like wine yet with a freshness that is very appealing. A good balance of acidity on the finish.

97. Gutierrez Colosia Fino Puerto 8
 Immediately fresh on the nose with light lemony citrus flowers, followed almost immediately with a fresh yeasty note— the hallmark of the flor. The zing continues with a little baker's yeast, a touch of green apple and a slightly salty tang. Aromatic and elegant, not overly complex, but youthful and zingy on the finish.

98. Gutierrez Colosia Amontillado Del Puerto 18
 A dry wine characterised by an intense and subtle nose with hints of sultanas. This is an old wine which has been aged using both ageing processes. It was Fino during three years and then started the oxidation process
